Braemar Stone

Similar to the modern day shot put, contestants are judged on the longest of three tosses, using a 22 pound stone.



Open Stone

Like the braemar, only using a lighter, 18 pound stone.

Weight for Distance

The objective of this strength event is to toss the 28# or 56# weight for distance. The weight is a ball and chain with a handle on the end. Only one hand may be used.



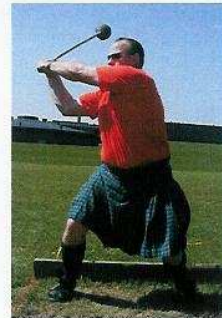
Weight Over Bar

The same weights are thrown one handed over a horizontal bar for height.

Heavy Hammer/Light Hammer

A round metal hammer head weighing 22# or 16# with a 50" shaft is thrown for distance.



Sheaf Toss

Using a three-tined pitchfork, the athletes hurl a 16# burlap bag stuffed with straw over a horizontal bar for height.



Caber Toss

The centerpiece of the modern Highland Games, the caber requires strength, balance and timing. A 19', 100-130# log must be heaved end-over-end. This toss is for accuracy, not distance.
